



ST. BONIFACE DIOCESAN HIGH SCHOOL INTERNATIONAL STUDENT 2010-2011 REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Step 1** Complete the Registration Forms. A complete Registration must include the following:
- A completed Application form
 - Original transcripts of the last school year
 - A current photograph
 - A non-refundable Registration fee of \$200 Canadian
- Step 2** Forward completed Registration Forms to:
- St. Boniface Diocesan High School

- Step 3** The Principal will decide on the acceptance and Grade placement of the student. An initial **Letter of Acceptance** will be prepared for the student to obtain their Visa, once the complete Registration has been received. A minimum deposit of \$1500 (Canadian) must be paid to the school upon receipt of this **Letter of Acceptance**. **This fee will be refunded only if their Visa application is declined.**
- Step 4** Once the student's Visa has been approved, and the Interview has been completed, a **Formal Letter of Acceptance** will be given to the student, outlining all necessary requirements for acceptance to St. Boniface Diocesan High School.
- Step 5** The following must be on file before the first day of classes:
- Copy of Birth Certificate
 - Copy of Current Visa
 - Proof of Medical Insurance (or application for medical insurance through the school with payment)
 - All Tuition paid

Application Fee

\$6,500.00 2nd and subsequent Student(s) of same family

*****Tuition will be prorated if student enrolls after September 30th.**

Refund Policy

1. International Student tuition fees are non-refundable unless one of the following occurs:
 - a) Visa is declined
 - b) There is a death in the student's immediate family or serious illness of the student which necessitates the student to return home
 - c) The student and/or parents become a Landed Immigrant before September 30th of the academic year. (Refunds will be the difference between International and Regular student fees)
Documentation is required for any of the above, to be considered for refund.

2. No refund of the tuition fee will be given if any of the following conditions apply:
 - a) The student is removed from the program because of:
 - A violation of St. Boniface Diocesan's Policies & Procedures
 - Engaging in illegal activities
 - b) The study permit is revoked by Citizenship & Immigration for just cause.
 - c) The student and/or parents become Landed Immigrants before September 30th and choose to attend another school.
 - d) The student and/or parents secure a Study Permit or Work Permit before September 30th and choose to attend another school.

Student and Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

I understand that a successful experience for International Students at St. Boniface Diocesan High School depends upon regular class attendance, completion of all homework and assignments, and participation in all activities.

I agree that the Principal will determine placement of the student in a grade appropriate program (regardless of the age of the student or the level of education completed).

If a student arrives more than 50% into a semestered program, the student will 'audit' the remainder of the program and will not receive credit for that portion of the program. Credit will be given for courses successfully completed in the following semester.

I acknowledge that St. Boniface Diocesan High School reserves the right to dismiss students, without tuition refund for violating any of the rules set out by the program (see refund policy) or engaging in illegal activities.

I agree to abide by St. Boniface Diocesan High School rules and to cooperate with administrators, teachers, and students.
