- Food for 200 people would be \$276.33. They could not guarantee this price for September.

This cost would include the following;

- 3.25 kg of coarse garlic sausage
- 3.25 kg of cooked ham
- 3.25 kg of corned beef
- 3.25 kg of salami
- 1.8 kg of cheddar cheese
- 1.8 kg of farmers cheese
- 8 liters of dills
- 6 X 320 gram bags of potato chips
- 7 lbs of pretzels
- 16 loaves of bread

They only prep required for the food would be to slice the dill pickles and arrange the meat and cheeses on platters for serving. The cheese comes already cubed. Veggies, dessert, mustard and butter would be left to purchase along with any other supplies.
