- Grades 7 – 8 Courses - \$225/course (non-resident); \$130/course (resident); (July 5<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup>)
- Grades 9 – 12 Repeater Courses – must have at least 30% in the course

- Grades 10 – 12 Non-Repeater Courses (July 5<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>)
